Circletalk is a secure, participant-led app that helps individuals with disability and support needs share the information that matters most—across community, creative, recreational, and supported living settings.

Whether someone is involved in a housing program, gardening group, music workshop, or supported sport, Circletalk helps managers, facilitators, and support workers know how to best engage with them from the start.

Used In:

- Arts, music, and creative therapy programs
- Sport and recreation programs
- Community garden or volunteering groups
- Supported Independent Living (SIL)
- Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA)
- Community housing or transitional

How it Works

- Managed by the participant or their nominated carer
- Supporters receive view-only access for free
- Individuals can remove or re-invite supporters as life changes
- Uses name or how the person identifies, and year of birth only
- No diagnosis or formal documentation required

Where do I start?

This service is available through the **NDIS** under Low-Cost Assistive Technology, or as a self-funded, fee-for-service option. It comes with a **one-off annual fee of \$390 AUD**. Participants can **unsubscribe and rejoin at any time**, making it a flexible option that adapts to their changing
